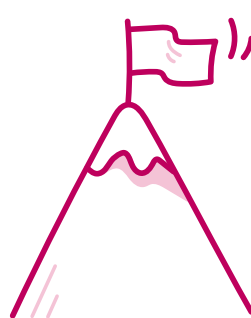
Why BCRF?

BCRF research has already impacted millions of women and men worldwide—and we're on the cusp of even more incredible breakthroughs that improve outcomes and end breast cancer for good. Your fundraising helps us make these goals reality. Here are the top three things that set BCRF apart:



We Fund the World's Top Scientists: From discovering the BRCA genes to pioneering groundbreaking treatments, BCRF researchers have been deeply involved in **every major advancement** in breast cancer prevention, treatment, diagnosis, metastasis, and survivorship since our founding in 1993.





Our Impact Is Unmatched: Not only is BCRF the **largest private funder of breast cancer research in the world**, but we're also the largest private funder of research on metastatic/stage 4 breast cancer, which takes more than 42,000 lives each year and can't be cured. Approximately 50% of BCRF's research investment this year is dedicated to metastatic breast cancer.



We're Number One: BCRF is proud to be the **highest-rated breast cancer research organization** in the U.S.



Every Dollar Counts

BCRF funding enables the most innovative minds in breast cancer research to pursue their best, boldest, and most out-of-the-box ideas. What does that look like? More time in the lab. More staff. More equipment and tools. More patients enrolled in clinical trials. Each donation, no matter how small or large, makes an impact and gives our researchers the resources they need to approach this disease from every angle.

Here are just a few examples of what your fundraising can support:

\$50 = 1 hour of research

\$100 = 5 liquid biopsy collection kits for a BCRF-supported clinical trial

\$500 = 1 patient's DNA sequencing in a BCRF-supported lab

\$1,000 = 1 month of general supplies for a BCRF-supported lab

\$2,500 = 1 patient's enrollment in a BCRF-supported clinical trial

Get Creative

BCRF could not advance our lifesaving mission without the creativity and passion of our thousands of fundraisers across the country. Whether they're going solo or teaming up with friends, family, or coworkers, our fundraisers make supporting research deeply meaningful and fun. And with one in eight women being diagnosed with breast cancer in her lifetime, a BCRF fundraiser is a great way to rally your community around a cause that touches so many people.

Fun Ways to Fundraise

Harness Your Hobbies: Share your talents and side hustles for research! Knit, make jewelry, paint, or do something else that you are passionate about.

Host a Gathering: A potluck, backyard BBQ, game night, or other get-together with your family and friends can become a fundraiser.

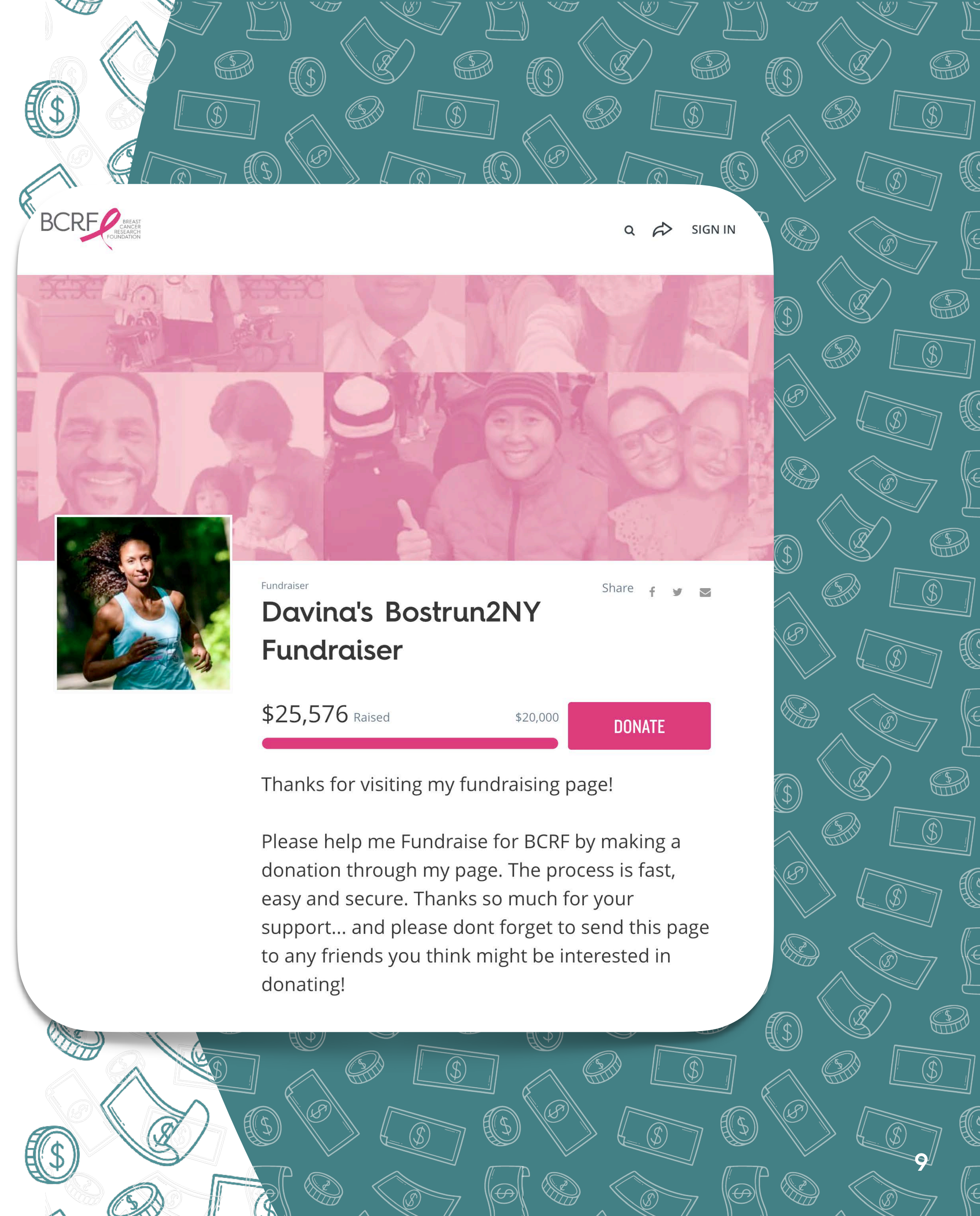

Getting Started: Tools to Know

BCRF is happy to offer all its fundraisers a free online fundraising tool to collect donations and track their impact! Whether you host your event in person or virtually, creating an online fundraising page is convenient, customizable, and secure. Family, friends and colleagues can support your efforts wherever they are, and you can see what you've raised in real time.

Use these three quick steps to start your online fundraiser:

- 1 **Create** an online fundraising page through <https://give.bcrf.org>. Set a fundraising goal.
- 2 **Personalize your page.** Add pictures and describe who or what inspired you to fundraise for BCRF.
- 3 **Spread the word.** Share your personalized fundraising page link with your friends and family.



Handling Cash and Checks

If you're given checks or cash from friends and family, you have a few options.

For cash, Venmo/Cash App gifts, and checks made out to you personally:

Share Your Why

Storytelling not only inspires others to share their own experiences, but it is also a powerful catalyst for action. When you give the “why” behind your fundraiser, you can inspire gifts and encourage your supporters to unite around your goal. Here are a few tips for harnessing the power of storytelling while you fundraise.

Personalization

Whether you’ve been diagnosed with breast cancer, supported a loved one through treatment, or lost someone to the disease, when you open up about your personal connection to breast cancer, you help your network understand why fundraising for breast cancer research is so urgent and important. Consider writing a little bit about what your experience with breast cancer was like—or how seeing a loved one be diagnosed impacted you. Personalize your fundraising page with photos of you or the person you’ve chosen to honor.

Provide Updates

Keep supporters in the loop by sharing your fundraising goal and any progress you've made. If you started an online fundraising page through BCRF, you can use the Updates feature to share milestones and thank you messages.

Spread the Word

There are many ways to promote your story and fundraiser, too. Posting on social media is a great way to get your fundraiser out to a lot of people at once. Direct phone calls, texts, and emails are an impactful way to speak on a personal level about why this cause is meaningful to you.
